Dirt Removed From Area Rug

Soil hides in carpet and rugs. That's part of the reason the fiber is so well used. On hard floors, every speck of dirt shows. But carpet and rugs can hide the soil. By the time an area rug appears visibly soiled, it's actually pretty full with soil. This is why carpet and rug manufacturers recommend yearly cleaning to maintain the appearance and longevity of the fibered flooring.

Today there are several means of removing dry soil from carpet and rugs. For area rugs, some companies prefer to use air dusting machines. However, new advancements have been made to mimic the old-fashioned rug beaters to gently vibrate soils from the backing of a rug. The most popular type of machine that does this is called the Rugbadger, which is manufactured by the Rugbadger Corporation. With this new technology, soils can be removed deep in the backing that a vacuum cleaner could never remove.

"You know how you can vacuum your rug ten times and still have dry soil in it? Vacuum cleaners are great for frequent maintenance and even a necessity. But rugs periodically need something quite a bit more to remove the deep, embedded dirt. We've been using the Rugbadger equipment to remove dry soil in rugs for a few years. It really does remove all the soil from a rug," said Peter Eckert, owner of SaniTech.
