Additionally, students now also have the option of obtaining a degree in fashion merchandising, marketing, design, and other related fields online."

Swanson stated that anyone who is seriously pursuing a fashion career should try to get as much actual work experience as they can before graduation, either through part-time work or internships. "Fashion internships are very competitive and really hard to find," Swanson concluded, "So most students will need to get their work experience through positions at good apparel retailers."
