No matter what is filling the gutters, once they are plugged the water starts spilling over the edge and collects around your home. When water builds up around the foundation, pressure from the weight of that water will begin to crack foundation walls and cause leaks.

Wet Basement Problems

Once foundation walls crack water will find its way in. A wet basement causes no end of trouble destroying floor, walls, furniture and if left unchecked can eventually cause toxic mold to form. This leads to what is termed as "sick building syndrome" and can lead to illness, allergies and related health problems.

Prevention VS Repairs

So many homeowners could avoid needless bills by taking simple precautions and setting up a maintenance schedule. We suggest making a list of things around the home that have moving parts, that are exposed to the elements or use filters. One of the biggest reasons plumbers and roofers exist is because of neglect. Think about that for a moment and realize how much money you could save by spending 10 or 12 hours each year replacing the furnace filter, cleaning the dryer vents, and of course cleaning your Vancouver gutters twice a year. ###
