The factors that are responsible for sewer line damage are quite numerous. The major ones are corrosion of sewer pipes, broken pipe, bellied pipe, disconnected joints, and growth of roots around sewer line.

But the problem is how do you find an expert to solve your sewer problem? Here are 3 effortless ways to go about it.

Use the web search

With people searching for silly things such as "how to die," you shouldn't find it difficult getting the address of a plumbing expert near you.

The process is simple: you need to narrow down your search with the keywords that are relevant to your search. But if you want to be more specific, you could add your location to the search term. It'd return tons of search results for you to pick from.

Make use of referrals

The use of referrals is probably the fastest way to [get any expert to work for you](#). It's easy because all you have to do is to know someone who has hired a similar service in the past. Not only does it help you get a hand as quick as possible, it also comes with an honest opinion/review of such person/services.

So if you know anybody; be it your friends, colleagues at work or family members who have just repaired or replaced their sewer, do ask them to refer you to their contact. Not only this, ask them also about their level of expertise and trustworthiness.

These two criteria will help you know whether you can patronize them or you need to consider other options. But if you can't find anybody who's ever done this, then you should ask around your neighbourhood or other technicians that you know.

Contact your local authorities

Not all sewers are privately owned. Most [sewers are handled by](#) the local water authorities but the owners of the house must pay certain amounts for its maintenance on a regular basis.

But assuming that your sewer isn't connected to the public sewer network and you can't find a competent hand to repair it for you, you could still contact the water authorities or the department of health.

You only need to pay an amount for the job. But you should have them connect your sewer to their network since most sewers are now publicly owned.
