People know it merely as "boating license". This boating license is a federal competency card which you'll need at all times if you want to drive a motorized boat in Canada. You can get your license with aceboater.

Is the Saskatchewan Boating License any good if I want to drive the boat in any other province, too?

The Saskatchewan Boat License is approved for every waterway which is public and which is placed in Canada. Of course, motorized boating must be allowed. You should always know the regulations for lakes for every province you want to go to, because, for example, some lakes might restrict any boating activity to paddle sports only.

Is the Pleasure Craft Operator Card compulsory to boat in Saskatchewan?

It is required that you have the Pleasure Craft Operator Card or the Canada Boat License to get to drive your motorized boat in the state of Canada legally. However, the PCOC can also be used to drive your boat in more than 40 U.S. states – we heard the south is a really good place for boating.

How can you get your Saskatchewan Pleasure Craft Operator Card?

For you to legally get the PCOC, you first need to take the Transport Canada Approved BOATsmart! course. After that, you need to pass the Boating Safety Test, of course. You can take the test online (find it on the official site), directly from the comfort of your home. After passing it, print your temporary PCOC immediately after.

How much time will it take for you to become a certified boat operator?

The Canada's Online Boating Course and the Transport Canada Test take about 3 hours in total. If you need the certificate right away, you can print the temporary Boating License Card immediately after you pass it. The permanent Pleasure Craft Operator Card should arrive in about four weeks.

Do boats need to be insured in Saskatchewan?

The boats in Saskatchewan don't need boat insurance. But getting a boat insurance may not be such a bad idea after all. Give it a though, and if you decide to get one for your boat, maybe you'll opt for the one offered from BOATsmart! Assure. You can even save up to 25%.

What's the minimum age in getting the Saskatchewan boat license?

There isn't one – in Saskatchewanat, at any age you can get a Pleasure Craft Operator Card. However, for those of you who are young, there are some supervision requirements and horsepower restrictions for you to follow.
