Don't miss out on the historic city of Granada

Approximately 1.5 hours drive from Malaga, Granada is not to be missed. The architecture here is beautiful and unforgettable, forged over 2,500 years of habitation by several civilisations, from the Moors to the Greeks and Romans.

The moorish palace of the Alhambra is an amazing example of that history, and you should be sure to visit the peculiar cave dwellings of Sacromonte and the Arabic quarter of Albaicin.

Enjoy a little luxury in Marbella

Just 60km from Malaga, and easy to get to by car is Marbella. Known for the glamorous Puerto Banus, where millionaires lined up their yachts, it is also the perfect place to visit stunning beaches and spend an afternoon strolling round the Old Town. In addition you there are some world class golf courses, high-end shopping and a vibrant and exciting nightlife if dancing away the hot summer nights is what you are after.

Explore the cliffs of Ronda

Around 1.5 hours drive away is Ronda. Split in half by the Guadalevin River, and connected by the spectacular Puente Nuevo that stands 100m from the ground you can explore both La Ciudad, the old Moorish quarter, and the more modern half, Mercadillo. Set in and around a great gorge you can take your fill of white washed houses and Roman and Moorish architecture.

Reach new heights on the Caminito del Rey

It takes a brave soul to take on the Caminito del Rey. Originally built in 1905, and restored recently, it consists of a narrow walkway 100m above the ground in a narrow gorge. The walk has some amazing views, and some glass sections to look down into the gorge. The walk takes around 4 hours, and is around 1 hours drive from Malaga. But be sure to book in advance, this tour can book out months in advance.

Explore a melting pot of culture in Cordoba

Around 158 km from Malaga is Cordoba, a place with an enticing mix of Jewish, Christian and Islamic cultures. The Mezquita is a world famous historical mosque-turned cathedral of great beauty and an unusual style. The huge bell tower gives great views across the town.

Head underground in Nerja

Around an hour from Malaga is Nerja. Known as the jewel of the Costa Del Sol, Nerja is a beautiful little town with

cobbled streets and stunning beaches. From the Balcon de Europa, originally constructed in 1487 you can take in amazing views of the coastline. And just outside the town you can explore even more, in the famous Caves of Nerja. A cave system stretching almost five kilometers, it has the world's oldest stalagmite and Neanderthal cave painted dated to around 42,000 years old.
