Expert Appliance Repair says that a general rule on whether to fix or replace the refrigerator is considering how old it is. If the refrigerator is broken down and is over ten years old, it might be better to get a new one. The cost of the repair is also an important consideration. If the repair cost is more than half the cost of buying a new refrigerator, it is recommended to just replace the refrigerator. The type, configuration and make of the refrigerator are factors to consider as well. Built-in refrigerators, according to Expert Appliance, are usually worth repairing. Side-by-sides should be repaired if they break within five years, bottom-freezers should be fixed within seven years, and top-freezers should be fixed within three years, but considered for repair in three-six years.

If the refrigerator was recently bought, or is between three to seven years old, Expert Appliance recommends to get it fixed. Some issues concerning refrigerators are actually quite easy to fix and may not even need the services of a technician at all. For example, if the refrigerator is no longer cooling as well as it used to, its condenser coils may just be dirty and need some cleaning.

However, for more serious problems, it is important to seek out the services of an experienced and skilled technician. Issues that may require a technician's knowledge and expertise include a lack of Freon, leakage in the system, heat coming out from behind the refrigerator which requires replacing the compressor, any other issue that requires the compressor to be fixed, and many more.
