the 4th largest high tide of the month will be coming in starting at 7:00 PM, and reaching its hightide point of 39 Inches at 11:19 PM.

The combination of the two, promises to bring a storm surge to the Florida Keys, not seen in over a century.

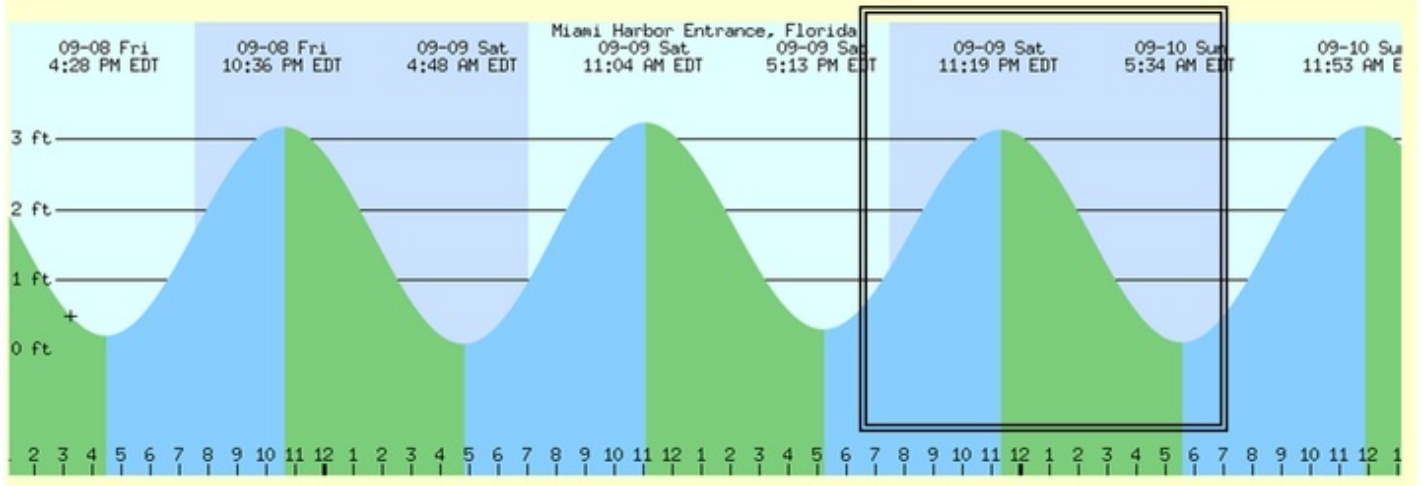


Latest location
