Scott Hultgren, PhD, the Helen L. Stoever Professor of Molecular Microbiology is one of the study's senior authors.

He said that their findings demonstrate how bacteria were able to evolve a mechanism in colonizing the bladder. The vaccination inhibited such a mechanism, and it could be a part of a viable approach in the prevention or treatment of these infections.

According to research, around 80 percent of UTIs are due to the *Escherichia coli*. In the United States, UTIs account for 8.1 million visits to doctors.

It has further been found that women are more susceptible to this infection due to the fact that they have a shorter urethra.

It is worth mentioning that when the infection becomes chronic, a pool of bacteria is able to survive in the bladder. This can spread to the kidneys or bloodstream, which makes it severe enough to need hospitalization.
